The Edmonton Police Service's (EPS) Youth Recruit Academy (YRA) offers high school students in Grades 10, 11 or 12 a look into what it takes to fill the boots of an EPS recruit constable. **Registration is free**, and youth get to work alongside EPS members, ask questions, and meet peers interested in a policing career.

For the first time, in celebration of its **10-year anniversary**, the 2024 Academy will run two sessions:
